Sub:- Upgradation as a High School on the recommendation of the State Govt. vide Memo No. 1089 -SE /S/3S-105/15 (Pt. II) dt. 15.12.2015 w.e.f. 01.01.2016 without any kind of financial assistance from Govt. of West Bengal.

Dear Sir,

I am directed to inform you that the Hon'ble President of the Board in exercise of the powers vested upon him u/s 28(2) of the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education Act, 1963, as amended, has been pleased to consider the report and recommendation of the State Govt. vide Memo No. 1089 -SE /S/3S-105/15 (Pt. II) dt. 24.09.2015 and to grant up-gradation to Pearl Rosary School (New), 40, Satish Chandra Ghosh Lane, P.O.- Mahesh, P.S. & Sub Divn.- Serampore, Dist- Hooghly, Pin Code No.- 712 202 (Co-Ed. & English Medium) as a X- Class High School (Class IX & Class X) without any kind of financial assistance from Govt. w. e. f. 1.1.2016 with permission to open Class - IX from 01.01.2016 and Class - X from 01.01.2017 provisionally for three years subject to fulfillment of normal conditions enclosed along with the additional conditions imposed by the School Education Deptt. vide Memo No. 1089 -SE /S/3S-105/15 (Pt. II) dt. 15.12.2015. The school will send up 1st batch of candidates at the Madhyamik Pariksha (Secondary Examination), 2018.

1. That the school authority shall never claim any financial assistance from the State Govt.
2. That the school authority shall implement the prescribed pay scales and allowances for the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school .
3. That the school authority shall provide retirement benefits to the teaching and non teaching staff of the school as per Death -cum -Retirement Benefit Scheme .
4. That the Managing Committee of the School shall be constituted with at least three guardian members, three elected teacher members and one non-teaching staff member.
5. That the school authority shall not enhance tuition fees charges without prior permission of the competent authority.
6. That the school authority shall not charge any capitation fee or its equivalent fee by any means.

07. That the recruitment of teachers shall be done in accordance with transparent, merit-based criteria, as laid down in the relevant Govt. Rules / Govt. Orders and information thereof shall be made available to the State Govt., if necessary.
08. That the funds raised by the school authority, the fees collected and income by any other source, shall not be utilized for other purpose than the welfare of the school and benefit of education of the students and the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.
09. That any type of change in the ownership of the school or handing over of property or management of the school and changing / amending the character of the Parent Body shall not be done without prior notice to the State Government.
10. That service of teaching and non-teaching staff shall not be terminated without giving opportunity of being heard by the competent authority and without observing due disciplinary proceedings.
11. That the service condition of the teaching and non-teaching staff including provisions of security of service, disciplinary proceedings and procedure for appeal shall be guided by directions laid down in the Govt. Rules / Orders.
12. Violation of all or any of the declarations as in para nos.1 to 11 in this Affidavit shall constitute sufficient reason for withdrawal of No Objection Certificate or upgradation, / affiliation as the case may be.
13. The school shall abide by procedure and rules and legal provisions that may be promulgated in this regard.

The school is allowed to admit Class -VIII pass students of recognized 4-class Junior High School or recognized High school on the basis of valid transfer certificate and should get those admitted students registered with the respective Regional Office in prescribed form with requisite fee within due date.

A report in the matter of fulfillment of conditions item-wise and seriatim attached to up-gradation should be forwarded to the Board positively within six months, with a copy to both the Director of School Education, W.B. and District Inspector of Schools (SE) concerned.

The conditions attached to this up-gradation as a High School are to be strictly complied with. In default, the Board reserves the right to cancel or withdraw recognition of the school.

The question of granting extension of the up-gradation of the school will be considered on fulfillment of conditions attached to this up-gradation.

Sub : Provisional recognition for imparting Higher Secondary Education

Ref : G.O. No. 926-SE/S/3S-21/17PT-III) Dated : 14/09/2018.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed by the President, Council to state that your institution has been accorded provisional recognition for introduction of Higher Secondary General Stream Courses w.e.f. 2019-2020 Session for two years on the following conditions:

1. That the institution will not introduce any subject without prior permission of the Council and the institution will not be allowed **initially** to introduce any subject for which they have no duly qualified teacher on pay roll;
2. That the institution will allow the Council to use its buildings, furniture etc, for examination and other academic purposes as and when necessary and the institution will fully co-operate with the Council in respect of above matters in all possible ways;
3. That the institution will collect relevant regulations and circulars regarding admission, migration, registration, examination etc. and 'Samsad Parichiti' from the Council;
4. That the institution will abide by the rules, regulations and provisions of the circulars of the Council from time to time.
5. That the institution will maintain enrolment prescribed by the Council, maximum 275 students and minimum 35 students for Govt. Aided Institution, maximum 500 students and minimum 75 students for self-Financed institution, in a year and will not admit students in excess of the prescribed limit;
6. That the institution will not hold Higher Secondary Classes in the morning or evening. The institution shall arrange for a total number of 39 periods of 45 minutes each per week;
7. That the provisional recognition accorded to the institution may be cancelled/ withdrawn / kept in abeyance if the institution fails to fulfil the above conditions as well as other conditions prescribed from time to time.
8. The set / stream which can be introduced from the current session are :-

Commerce, Science and Arts

9. The subjects which can be introduced from the current session are :-

**ALTE BNGA ENGA ENGB HINA ACCT BSTD CLPA CSTX ECON EDCN HIST MATH POLS
BIOS CHEM COMA COMS GEGR PHYS**

10. Till such time the institution

a) Can engage duly qualified teachers solely out of their own resources without putting any liability either on the Council or on the Government against the NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE issued by the Council signed by the concerned teacher and duly countersigned by the Head of the Institution;

OR

b) Can approach the CSE, WB for engaging duly qualified Retired Teachers as Guest Teachers as mentioned in

G.O. No. 926-SE/S/3S-21/17PT-III) Dated : 14/09/2018.

11. In case of teaching laboratory- based subjects, the institution must submit documents authenticated by the D.I. (SE) of the respective district to the Council for getting permission. If there is no proper laboratory facilities immediately available to the student, the institution will not allowed to enrol the students in those subjects till any documents is received by the Council fulfilling all the stipulated norms and conditions.
12. In offering subject combination, provisions of Council's Admission & Examination Regulations 2006 (with Amendments) should be strictly followed.
13. That the Institution shall not introduce Co-education system without Council's permission and for introduction of the same the Institution shall apply to the Deputy Secretary (Academic) through concerned D.I. of Schools (SE) with the report of DI of Schools.
14. At the time of Renewal of Recognition for further years, the institution must apply in the Council's prescribed proforma along with the requisite papers positively three months prior to the date of expiry of the existing Recognition Memo; failing which the Renewal may not be given and enrolment of students may not be recognised by the Council. If the school applies for renewal of recognition in due time - there is no fees but after due date the late fee is 2000/- per year.
